JesusJournal.com is part of the MARKINC Ministries network.

We respect and are committed to protecting your privacy. That is why we have adopted this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy lets you know how your personal information is processed and used. We promise that we will take steps to use your personal information only in ways that are compatible with this Privacy Policy. The following policies are only in effect for the Web pages, newsletters, discussion lists and opt-in announcement lists owned and operated by MARKINC Ministries. The following discloses our Privacy Policy.

What information are you collecting and how are you collecting it?

Every computer connected to the Internet is given a domain name and a set of numbers, that serve as that computer's "Internet Protocol" IP address. When a visitor requests a page from any Web site within the MARKINC Ministries Network, our Web servers automatically recognize that visitor's domain name and IP address. The domain name and IP address reveal nothing personal about you other than the IP address from which you have accessed our site. We use this information to examine our traffic in aggregate, but do not collect and evaluate this information for individuals. Our Web servers do not record e-mail addresses of the visitors.

What are cookies?

From time to time, MARKINC Ministries network sites or its advertisers may send a "cookie" to your computer. A cookie is

a small piece of data that is sent to your browser from a web server and stored on your computer's hard drive. A cookie can't read data off your hard disk or read cookie files created by other sites. Cookies do not damage your system. We use cookies to identify which areas of MARKINC Ministries web sites you have visited or customized, so the next time you visit, those pages may be readily accessible. Our advertisers may also use cookies to ascertain how many times you've seen an advertisement. We and our advertisers may use this information to better personalize the content, banners, and promotions that you see on our Site.

You can choose whether to accept cookies by changing the settings of your browser. You can reset your browser to refuse all cookies, or allow your browser to show you when a cookie is being sent. If you choose not to accept these cookies, your experience at our site and other Web sites may be diminished and some features may not work as intended.

What other information do you request?

We may also request your e-mail address or mailing address for the purposes of conducting a survey or to provide additional services (for example, subscriptions to e-mail newsletters, announcement lists or other information) Whenever we request the identity of a visitor, we will clearly indicate the purpose of the inquiry before the information is requested. We do not rent or give our lists to third parties.

Regardless of where on our site your e-mail address is supplied, you will automatically be added to the Jesus Journal Weekly list so that we may update you on our products, services, events and polices. You may opt-out of this list at any time, as is the case with all our lists.

We may from time to time send e-mail announcing new MARKINC Ministries initiatives.

When you sign up for an JesusJournal.com mailing list your name or alias is recorded solely for purposes of maintaining your own account within the forums. This information is not used to monitor your activity within a forum, nor is it used to identify you outside the MARKINC Ministries network in any way.

If you choose to purchase something online, we need to know your name, e-mail address, mailing address, credit card

number, and expiration date. This allows us to process and fulfill your order and to notify you of your order status. This information may also be used by us to notify you of related product and services, but will not be shared or sold to third parties for any purpose.

When you enter a contest or other promotion, we may ask for your name, address, and e-mail address so we can administer the contest and notify winners.

Wherever a site of the MARKINC Ministries network collects personal information we make an effort to include a link to this Privacy Policy on that page.

Will you disclose the information you collect to outside third parties?

MARKINC Ministries will disclose personal information when required by law or in the good-faith belief that such action is necessary to:

- 1) Conform to the edicts of the law or comply with a legal process served on MARKINC Ministries or JesusJournal.com,
- 2) Protect and defend the rights or property of the MARKINC Ministries network of sites, or visitors to JesusJournal.com,
- 3) Identify persons who may be violating the law, the legal notice, or the rights of third parties,
- 4) Cooperate with the investigations of purported unlawful activities.

MARKINC Ministries uses reasonable precautions to keep the information disclosed to us secure. However, we are not responsible for any breach of security or for any actions of any third parties which receive the information.

MARKINC Ministries network of sites also links to a wide variety of other sites and contains advertisements of third parties. We are not responsible for their privacy policies or how they treat information about their users. See below, What else should I know about my privacy when online?

What else should I know about my privacy when online?

MARKINC Ministries network of Web sites contains many links to other Web sites. MARKINC Ministries is not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such Web sites. MARKINC Ministries does not share any of the individual personal information you provide JesusJournal.com with the sites to which JesusJournal.com links, although JesusJournal.com may share aggregate data with such Web sites (such as how many people use our site).

Please check with those sites to determine their privacy policy.

Please keep in mind that whenever you voluntarily disclose personal information online - for example through e-mail, discussion lists, or elsewhere - that information can be collected and used by others. In short, if you post personal information online that is accessible to the public, you may receive unsolicited messages from other parties in return.

Ultimately, you are solely responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your personal information. Please be careful and responsible whenever you're online.
